

# AARES 2026 Social Networking Night at the Glenelg Surf Life Saving Club and Moseley Beach Club

Thursday 11 February, 6.00 pm – 9.00 pm

The Social Networking Night is held at the [Glenelg Surf Life Saving Club](#) and the adjacent [Moseley Beach Club](#), in Adelaide's premier beach suburb Glenelg.

The **Glenelg Surf Life Saving Club** is a relaxed beachfront venue overlooking the iconic Glenelg Beach. With sweeping ocean views, a welcoming coastal atmosphere, and a bar and bistro enjoyed by locals and visitors alike, it's a great place to unwind by the sea. As a not-for-profit surf lifesaving club, every visit also supports the important work of keeping our beaches safe.



The **Moseley Beach Club** is Australia's only beach club of this kind, operating on the sand just north of the famous Glenelg Jetty. With a full menu and absolute waterfront views it is a must when in South Australia.



There will be two shuttle buses from the conference venue to the Glenelg Surf Life Saving Club and back (see details below).

Please come along to enjoy a relaxed atmosphere, a beautiful sunset at the beach, reconnect with old colleagues or meet new friends. Those who want to swim are also welcome to!

The cost to attend the social night is \$60, which includes the shuttle bus, drinks and canapes.

## **Shuttle bus and way finding**

### **Leaving Adelaide Convention Centre (17.15h and 17.30h)**

There will be two buses taking you to Glenelg for the Social Networking Night on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2026.


Both buses leave from 92 North Terrace, close to the convention centre west-side escalator exit (Blue dot on map) opposite.

**Bus 1** departs at **17.15h sharp**

**Bus 2** departs at **17.30h sharp**

LOC volunteers will be around on the bus and to guide to the Social night.

Your other choice is to make your own way down there by catching the Adelaide metro tram down to Glenelg (meant to be operating once again from end Jan 2026).




### **Arriving at Glenelg Surf Life Saving Club / Mosley's Beach Bar (~18.00h)**

The busses will drop you off at **the Wigley Reserve Temporary Bus Zone, Anzac Highway Glenelg**. From there it is only a short walk to the Glenelg Surf Life Saving Club at the beach (see map). The Mosley's Beach club is directly on the beach in front of the Glenelg Surf Life Saving Club.

The two venues have been booked, as the Glenelg LSC has a capacity of 60 people, and the Mosley's Beach club booths have been booked – and have a capacity of up to 48 people for food and drink (though there is also space in front of the booths in tables and chairs).

In the event of rain, the Mosley Beach club may need to move into their restaurant which is on Jetty road, a minute's walk away.



**Leaving Glenelg (20.00h and 21.00h)**

Buses will take you back to the city (Adelaide Convention Centre pickup spot).

**Bus 1 departs at 20.00h sharp** from where you were dopped of at Glenelg

**Bus 2 departs at 21.00h sharp** from where you were dropped of at Glenelg

If you want to remain in Glenelg for longer (or leave earlier), the Adelaide Metro tram, and Adelaide Metro Buses 167, 168, 190, 265, H20 (amongst others) will take you back to the CBD. Services run typically every 10-20 minutes until midnight. You can use the [Adelaide Metro Website](#) or Google maps to plan your journey.
